

## Syllabus for Mrs. Bartley--Reading

OVERVIEW--In this class, students will read different genre and authors, use various reading skills, learn new vocabulary, work on, projects and have a great time.

GRADES--Students will be graded on daily work, quizzes, AR, projects and tests.
